## KEY THEMES:

### RESILIENCE

UK Government considers resilience as the ability of assets, networks and systems to anticipate, absorb, adapt to and rapidly recover from a disruptive event. With the onus on water companies to ensure resilience is achieved in their network, we discuss how this can be done through the application of UV assets, their redundancy, resistance, reliability, and response recovery.

### THE UV ROADMAP

UV has now firmly established itself as a stable and effective disinfection technology, but with competition increasing and technological boundaries being pushed we look at what is possible and what is feasible.

### VALIDATIONS

With nearly nine years since the DWI accepted UV as a formal disinfection solution for the UK drinking water market we look at how the science of validation has influenced UV performance, UV plant design, and how it has influenced disinfection policies across the country.

During the course of the day various case studies will be presented to help provide tangible examples of how specific themes have been achieved by neighbouring water companies.
